Area: Breedekloof area/Western Cape

Vines per hectare: 3360 vines/ha

Irrigation: Yes

Age of vines: 10 years

Soil types: Alluvial, sandy & stoney

Weather

Cold winters with an average of 500ml of rain per year.

Summers are dry but afternoon winds cool down the vines.

Harvesting

Mid February to mid March. Early mornings till early afternoons.

Yields per hectare: 15tons per hectare.

Cellar

Blended after fermentation to the cellar master's choice.

Wine

Colour: Light yellow

Bouquet: Fresh tropical flavours.

Taste: A sweeter fruity wine.

Serving suggestion: Easy drinking. Serve with light dishes.
